

**Dear Community Leader:** 

It's time to start thinking about the 2017 Downtown Garden City Santaland Parade. This year marks the 57th Anniversary year and we're hoping to make this another great parade. The parade continues to be put together by a committee of volunteers under the umbrella of the Garden City Community Coalition. The 2016 parade was another huge success with three high school marching bands, the Redford Unicycle club, classic cars, old time bicycles, Shriners, horses, team mascots, the Great Lakes Garrison- Michigan's premier Imperial Star Wars costuming group, a 100 year old Currier and Ives sleigh to transport Santa and more

The parade was watched by thousands on the route and even more through the parade's social media efforts on YouTube and Facebook.

The 2017 Downtown Garden City Santaland Parade is Saturday, November 25 at 10am.

Once again, the Downtown Development Authority has agreed to serve as the title sponsor of the parade covering the cost of police overtime and barricades to make the parade route safe.

The Santaland parade is completely self-funded. Every year we reach out to the community in an effort to raise the money to keep the parade going and this year is no exception.

Last year's response from the business community was again outstanding and the parade was able to raise over \$9,000 to pay for its costs. We hope to raise enough money again this year to allow us to invite all of last year's entries back, and more, as well as pay for staging and other expenses necessary to operate the parade. In 2016, along with the support of the DDA, major contributions were made by the Buccilli Group (\$2,000), Garden City Hospital (\$1,000) and the DTE Energy Foundation (\$1,000). A \$700 in-kind donation was made by Inkorporate Graphics and \$500 donations came in from Fleming Financial Services, Gordon Chevrolet, Barsamian Family Dentistry, the Santeiu Family, Garden City Medical Center, Orin's Jewler's and Harris Funeral Homes. Donations of \$300 were received from McKenna and Associates and Hemming, Polaczyk, Cronin, and Whitoff. \$250 was donated by Mayor Randy Walker and his wife Linda, Hershey's Shoes and GC Ace Hardware. \$100 was donated by Party Animal Travel.

We know that there are many deserving charities in this area, especially at the Holiday, but our hope is that you will find a way to contribute to this tradition that has been shared by generations.

Rather than just take your money, we want to keep you as a partner. For over ten years now we've offered a well received plan that allows for different sponsorship levels that in return give you visibility in the parade. In the last year we have added a Facebook component as well as a You Tube page that allows people from all over the world to know that that you supported this great holiday tradition.
