

#### Dear Community Leader:

It's time to start thinking about the 2019 Downtown Garden City Santaland Parade. This year marks the 59th Anniversary year and we're hoping to make this another great parade. The parade continues to be put together by a committee of volunteers under the umbrella of the Garden City Community Coalition. The 2018 parade was another huge success with four high school marching bands, the Redford Unicycle club, the Detroit Tigers Paws and the Detroit Lions Roary, classic cars, old time bicycles, Shriners, horses, the Great Lakes Garrison- Michigan's premier Imperial Star Wars costuming group, Garden City High



School league champs, Miss Michigan USA, floats, dozens of local entries, a 100 year old Currier and Ives sleigh to transport Santa and more.

The parade was watched by thousands on the route and by over 10,000 through the parade's social media efforts on YouTube and Facebook.

The 2019 Downtown Garden City Santaland Parade is Saturday, November 30 at 10am.

Once again, the Downtown Development Authority has agreed to serve as the title sponsor of the parade. Among other parade elements supported through the DDA sponsorship, we are able to cover the cost barricades to make the parade route safe and rent support items necessary for the parade's operation.

The Santaland parade is completely self-funded. Every year we reach out to the community in an effort to raise the money to keep the parade going and this year is no exception. Last year's response from the business community was again outstanding and the parade was able to raise over \$13,000 (Not including the \$7,000 from the DDA) to pay for its costs. We hope to raise enough money again this year to allow us to invite all of last year's entries back, and more, as well as pay for staging and other expenses necessary to operate the parade.

In 2018, along with the support of the DDA, major contributions were made by the Buccilli Group (\$3,000), the DTE Energy Foundation, the Suburban Collection (\$2,000) and a \$700 in-kind donation was made by Inkorporate Graphics.

\$500 donations came in from Fleming Financial Services, Garden City Hospital, Gordon Chevrolet, the Santeiu Family, Garden City Medical Center, Orin's Jeweler, Comcast and American Pavement Sawing. Donations of \$250 were received from Dr. Harvey Ellis, DDS, Midwest Cardiology Associates, Plymouth Physical Therapy Specialists, Hershey's Shoes, Schoolcraft College and Sign A Rama. Donations were also received from Sports Venue, Plato's Place and ACE Hardware.
